

The Main Directions of Military Patriotic Education

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Annotation: This article discusses the role of educating students in the spirit of military patriotism in educational institutions.

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Every direction, like socio-political activity, has a certain system, a formal style in the work of military patriotism.

It includes specific tasks, content of forms and methods, tools, as well as state and public enterprises, organizations and institutions that perform specific functions.
