

"Innovative Technologies, Problems and Their Solutions in Foreign Language Teaching"

Solution

There are a number of ways to do this. One of them is that the student should use audio materials extensively to learn the correct pronunciation of sounds and words. Independently, watching movies in a foreign language and watching videos on language teaching can serve, at least in part, as a bridge. Second, teachers also have a role to play in teaching English, and motivation and interest in the lesson play a key role. In addition, the use of different methods in language teaching should be considered, as it helps teachers to create appropriate conditions for students to learn English and to help students deal with learning problems. In short, the use of innovative methods in English lessons develops students' logical thinking skills, fluency, and the ability to respond quickly and accurately. Such methods stimulate the student's desire for knowledge. The student tries to prepare well for the lessons. This makes students active participants in the learning process.
