However, we have not yet been able to fully master two-dimensional images and use its potential effectively.

Creation of 15 full-length feature films in paragraph 5 of the decree on the establishment of the "Uzbekkino" National Agency dated March 16, 2004; It is planned to make a double-negative of each feature film and 15 copies for wide screening in the regions, and 2 copies with foreign language subtitles for release to the world market.

We can say "yes" to the question. Because every year, the agency produces 15 full-length feature films, although there are few cartoons.

There is another side of the issue that concerns us. It would be even better if a certain part of the funds allocated by our state were spent on educating the masters of tomorrow's cinematography.

Today, in most of the feature and video films created in the private and state cinema sector, directors and screenwriters have been exchanging with each other. Or, on the contrary, the director, screenwriter, lead actor, and even the director of editing will be the same person.

The saddest thing is that people who do not know the basics of film directing, let alone the laws of dramaturgy, are trying to make movies. Seeing the films they have made, the logical errors made in the films, one feels pity. They know that the movie will not be great if they force advertising, but they blindly make this mistake.

In 1999-2000, A. Shahobiddinov and Yo. Apart from Toychiyev, no director has been trained in foreign countries until now. Our teachers, who teach specialized subjects at the Art Institute, boast that "we have a good teaching system.

"It is true that we also admit that, in fact, we have a well-established education system, but it is no secret that there is a gap in technical support. In the new era, where the results of innovative cooperation produce products quickly, the development of technology cannot wait. New technologies are entering our country. We have to learn today's technology before we can master yesterday's technology. It is no secret that there are no engineers who can fully use the technical equipment brought to the "Uzbekfilm" film studio. Expensive technical equipment imported from abroad does not fulfill its functional tasks.

On April 7, 2021, the decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On bringing film art and industry to a new level, further improving the system of state support of the industry" [2] was announced. Clause 1, paragraph 4 of the Decree "creates an effective system of personnel training in the field of cinematography, improving the skills of filmmakers and technicians; defined.

On June 19, 2021, the decision of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On the revival and holding of the Tashkent International Film Festival" [3] was announced. In the decision, the "Tashkent International Film Festival of Asian, African and Latin American Countries" held in Uzbekistan during the years 1968-1997 will be restored under the name of the "Masterpiece of the Silk Road" Tashkent International Film Festival, and starting from 2021, Tashkent will be held annually in September-October. was determined to be held in the city. At the same time, paragraph 1 of the decision stipulates "in cooperation with representatives of foreign film art, conducting scientific research and research in this field, sharing mutual experience, organizing conferences, roundtable discussions, presentations and master classes with the participation of well-known film representatives.

It is clear that we have a big responsibility ahead of us. The festivals held in 2022-2023 showed that we have great responsibilities and our passion for sharing experiences.

In the field of education, many tasks include sending young pedagogues for training abroad, organizing training courses in directing, replenishing the material base of the institute with the most modern technical tools, attracting specialists who teach the use of these techniques, specialists who have mastered computer programs to pedagogy. shows that we should do.
