

# The Beginning of a New Era in Leather and Footwear in Uzbekistan

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**Annotation:** A new package of privileges has been announced in the field of leather and footwear. In 2022, the leather industry is being supported. In the neighborhoods, measures are being taken to slaughter livestock and launch small mobile services for skin harvesting.

**Keywords:** Leather and footwear, skin reserves, small-horned livestock skin, economical industrial zones.

**Log in.** Nowadays there are many privileges in the field of leather and footwear in our land. For example, in 2022, \$60 million (U.S.) was granted to support the leather industry. While the previously granted tax and corporate privileges were extended for another five years, new tax credits were introduced. 16 small industrial zones were opened in the area.

On January 24, President Shavkat Mirziyoyev held a meeting to discuss priority tasks in the leather industry.

According to an official release, in 2017, 76 billion gallons [76 billion L] of leather products were produced in the country, compared with 4 trillion gallons [4 trillion L] of leather products in 2021. That is, production has grown nearly 6 times, exports have grown 4 times. The usushi of finished products increased from 32% to 78%.

Although there are 2 million stores of leather reserves annually in Bukhara and Khmer Rouge, it has been produced in industrial mode. There are 1,800,000 small-scale livestock skins per year in poverty, 700,000 in Nairobi, and 500,000 in the tashkent region. Many birds are operating at low capacity because they are located far from the population, and are not connected to neighborhoods.

The meeting outlined additional measures for the systematic development of the industry by addressing such issues.

First of all, it was said that in the neighborhoods, it was necessary to provide small mobile services for watering livestock and harvesting their skins, and to allocate privileged loans. The delegates reported on 248 projects worth a total of \$421 million, which are expected to be implemented this year. The timely launch of enterprises by Sha'drach, Me'shach and A'bed'ne'go, as well as the establishment of 16 small industrial zones that have been economical to the network in The Watchtower, Oltinql, Shahrixon, Jondor, Namangan, Urgut, Margillon, Samarkand, Jezreel, Qarshi, and Narafshon.

It is reported that this year it is intended to increase exports of leather products to \$500 million and \$1 billion to \$200 million in the next 3 years.

" that's a huge margin. To achieve this goal, there is also a market, there is a large amount of hom-materials, and there is an applicant. Only to do this should create all the conditions for businesspeople," said Shavkat Mirziyoyev.

To that end, the previously granted tax and corporate privileges have been extended until 2026. Some of the efforts to attract foreign specialists will also be covered.

Today, the volume of leather products produced in Uzbekistan accounts for 23% of women's shoes and 8% of children's shoes, so it was instructed to pragmatize this direction through tax privileges.

"The biggest issue is the lack of specialists. "Therefore, all regions should have a clear plan in this regard and establish a system for training standards in places," the President said.

The Tashkent Institute of Textile and Chemical Engineering has been tasked with establishing an innovative educational and manufacturing laboratory, improving the skills of specialists abroad, and preparing

middle-class workers. At the meeting, network experts, governors, and businesspeople spoke and made their proposals.

It was also tasked with launching a separate program to support and support craftsmen. They are granted privileged loans and a variety of tax credits within the framework of family business and housing programs.
