

The Role of International Relations in Improving the Quality of Higher Education (On the Example of Activities of Surkhandarya Higher Education Institutions)

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Annotation: This article provides a detailed analysis of the interaction of higher education institutions with prestigious foreign higher education institutions in Surkhandarya region during the years of independence, in particular, the history of joint educational programs and joint projects on the example of Temiz State University and Denau Institute of Entrepreneurship and Pedagogy. Made.

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During the years of independence, Surkhandarya region has made great strides in the socio-economic and cultural spheres, and the lifestyle and culture of the population have improved in all respects. Especially in the field of education, a lot has been done since independence. It has been cooperating with a number of foreign educational institutions and organizations since 1992. These include prestigious higher education institutions in China, Germany, the United Kingdom, the Czech Republic, France, Japan, Poland, South Korea, Russia, the United States, Italy, and the European Commission's Erasmus +, as well as the DAAD, the Goethe Institute, and the British Council. , JICA, KOICA, TICA, ITEC and many other international institutions and projects in the field of education.

In 2019, a total of about 30 professors and teachers from higher education institutions of Germany, Russia, France, Tajikistan, Poland, Japan, China, the Czech Republic, Kazakhstan and the Republic of Azerbaijan will study German, Russian, English, history and archeology. Lectures and master classes in Tajik language, pedagogy, economics and tourism, biology and geography, physics and mathematics. Specialists from SES (Senior Expert Service) of Germany and KOICA of Korea are also used in conducting trainings in German, English and Korean.

Ilka Bixbeimer, a representative of the Senior Experts Service of the Federal Republic of Germany, conducted a seminar on education in Germany on January 12-28, 2019 with students of the German language department of the Faculty of Foreign Philology.

-Takahashi Toshikazu, Unzer-Shuts Giankarla- Associate Professors of Rissyo University, Japan, March 7-9, 2019 at Termez State University, gave lectures on the entry of Japanese companies abroad, Manga in the world and the world in Manga.

-Mr. Johannes Stikel- Expert of the Senior Expert Service of the Federal Republic of Germany, on September 7-26, 2019, conducted training sessions with students of German and English at the Faculty of Foreign Philology.

- Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the People's Republic of Bangladesh to Uzbekistan Massoud Mannanwa and his adviser visited Chandra Debnath Termez State University in Nripen. During the meeting, talks were held between Termez State University and Bangladeshi universities on cooperation.

- Two archeological professors from the French Republic, Pontbriand Ségolène and Leriche Pierre, visited Termez State University under a cooperation agreement between the French Laboratory of Western and Eastern Philology and Archeology (CNRS-ENS UMR 8546) in Paris. The purpose of the visit is to organize archeological monuments of ancient and medieval times in the Surkhandarya oasis and to conduct archeological research with the participation of professors and students of Termez State University. On November 19, 2019, Mr. Wang Ji, a professor at Northwestern University of China, visited Dtsin University to discuss the construction of a research institute (consisting of a laboratory, museum and dormitory) funded by the Chinese government.

- From November 1, 2019 to January 30, 2020, Ms. Dorota Maevich, Associate Professor of Gdansk State University, Poland, conducts classes in English for students majoring in English.

- Prof. Shodmon Vohidov, Vice-Rector for Research and Innovation of the Panjikent State Pedagogical Institute in Tajikistan, gave a lecture to students of Termez State University on December 3-4, 2019.

- Ambassador of Germany to Uzbekistan Gunther Overfeld 2019

On December 12, he met with the leadership of the university and students of the German language, as well as teachers of the same department. Cooperation with Germany was discussed.

- Associate Professor of Medical Biology, Voronezh State University of Russia, Candidate of Biological Sciences Solodovnikova Olga gave a lecture on specialty subjects to university students on November 18-23, 2019.

- On November 20, 2019, 2 experts from KOICA visited Kim Byungluham in Seo Ungab for 2 years to conduct additional training in Korean language for university students.

- On November 14, 2019, the head of the German company Praktikum-people Heike Withop visited the university to meet with the leadership of the University and students of the faculties of Economics and Tourism, Natural Sciences and Physics and Mathematics on internships in Germany. Turkish Ambassador to Uzbekistan Mehmet Sureyya Erham met with the head of the Turkish International Cooperation and Development Agency (TIKA) Ali Ihsan Chaglarbilan Rector of the University. The sides exchanged views on establishing cooperation with Turkey's Marmara and Istanbul universities, teaching Turkish language, and exchanging students in the fields of tourism, light industry and textiles.

I have to say this as a proof of the scale of the work being done. On the basis of the efforts of the head of our state, another educational institution DTPI has been established in Denau district of Surkhandarya region. It has been cooperating with a number of foreign educational institutions and organizations since 2020. Implementation of the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated October 27, 2020 No 655 "On measures for the transformation of higher education institutions in cooperation with prestigious foreign higher education institutions" in accordance with paragraph 2 d of the order No. 269 on ensuring the execution of the decision No.

1. Memorandums of Understanding were signed with a number of higher education institutions in the Russian Federation on the development of joint educational programs, joint diplomas, academic mobility and integrated innovative educational programs for summer schools. In particular, cooperation with Altai

State University, Moscow State Linguistic University, Minsk State Linguistic University, as well as Adygea State University has been established. At our institute today

1. Cooperation agreements were signed with 8 universities of Russia, 1 university of Belarus, 1 university of Kyrgyzstan and 10 universities of the Republic of Tajikistan. Numerous joint events have been held under the agreements. In addition, cooperation has been established with Russkiy Mir and Russian cooperation organizations. It is also planned to establish scientific contacts with leading universities in Latvia and Ukraine.

3. In May 2021, the traditional international scientific-practical conference dedicated to the memory of the famous Russian linguist and literary scholar, academician VV Vinogradov was held. The conference was attended by professors and teachers of leading higher education institutions of the Russian Federation and the country.

A cooperation agreement has been signed with the Dushanbe Branch of the Moscow State University named after MV Lomonosov.

4. In order to attract a wide range of leading scientists and specialists working abroad, online webinars are being organized with a number of foreign professors and doctoral students. Discussions with Alisher Umridinov, Professor of Law, Nagoya University of Economics, Japan, on the foreign economic diplomacy of New Uzbekistan, with Valijon Turakulov, Candidate of International Trade, Inha University, South Korea. An online webinar was organized on the topic.

Professors and teachers actively participated in all online conferences organized in cooperation with the British Council to improve the quality of education, improve curricula and programs, assess knowledge, introduce new curricula, implement various projects to improve the skills of English teachers.

Neighboring higher education institutions of the Republic, including Russian-Tajik (Slavic) University, Tajik Technical University named after M.Osimi, Tajik State University of Finance and Economics, Tajik State Pedagogical University named after S.Aini, Tajik National University, Tajik Technological University, Bakhtar Memorandums of cooperation have been signed with the State University, the Tajik Institute of Languages named after S.Ulugzoda, the University of Tourism, Entrepreneurship and Service of Tajikistan, and a wide range of cooperation is underway.

A scientific and practical conference has been organized in cooperation with Fujivara San, Director of the International Language Center at the prestigious University of Sukuba, Japan, and negotiations are underway to establish joint educational programs and student exchanges.

In 2020-2021, a joint language course on teaching Korean as a second language has been opened at the Royal Sejong Institute of South Korea to improve the quality of education and apply advanced foreign experience in the educational process.

A scientific and practical conference was organized in collaboration with Askarali Karimov, Director of Agriculture and Mechanics at the prestigious University of Texas at Dallas, USA. Was carried out.

In the 2021-2022 academic year, the project on mutual loan program Erasmus + (Sredit Mobility) with leading foreign countries, including Tokat Gaziosmapasa University of the Republic of Turkey, was approved. An initial agreement was reached on February 20, 2021, Altai State University, Russian Tajik (Slavic) University and Denau Institute of Entrepreneurship and Pedagogy organized a joint publication of articles by teachers of the Department of Russian Language and Literature. International roundtables were held on the topic of accelerating the activities of

on March 29, 2021, with the participation of professors and students of the Department of International Relations, Foreign Languages and Literature and the Department of History and Philosophy of the Institute in collaboration with Dilnoza Khalilova, PhD student at the University of Wyoming, organized an online course on International Languages and the Key to the World.

On March 30, 2021, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Ukraine to Uzbekistan Nikolai Doroshenko and members of the delegation held a meeting in Denau district to expand opportunities in the field of animal husbandry, implement joint projects in the district, import pedigree cattle from Ukraine and their care.

Famous Turkish photographer Orhan Durgut organized an international photo exhibition on March 31, 2021 on the historical cities of the Muslim world. Orhan Durgut introduced the professors and students of the institute with a major project called Islamic Cities.

Professors of TEAM University, Praviin Malla from India and Alan Buckingham from England on April 9-10, 2021 to the students of the Department of Digital Economics and Foreign Languages and Literature The role of higher education institutions in the development of the digital economy master classes on issues such as ensuring participation in the space and their solutions.

A scientific and practical conference was organized in cooperation with Fujivara San, Director of the International Language Center at the prestigious University of Sukuba, Japan, and further discussions were held on the organization of joint educational programs and student exchanges.

The website of the Denau Institute of Entrepreneurship and Pedagogy contains information and advertisements in Uzbek, Russian, English and Tajik languages, which provide information about the university's attractiveness, university activities, opportunities, as well as its convenience for foreign students.

In order to increase the prestige of the institute in the international arena, the following work has been done to invite foreign students to study:

Booklets about our institute, information about admission quotas were delivered to Tajik partner universities and widely disseminated;

Currently, 7 young people from the Republic of Tajikistan are studying at our institute;

In addition, six foreign teachers currently work at our institute. Five of them are citizens of the Republic of Tajikistan and one is a citizen of the Republic of Korea.

Conclusion:

The strength of any country is determined by the spiritual maturity and intellectual potential of its citizens. The development of society, national prosperity has always been associated with the education of the younger generation, new personnel with deep knowledge of modern knowledge, their high qualifications. Therefore, from the first steps of our independence, the work of educating a new generation in our country, the formation of their worldview on the basis of new values has risen to the level of state policy. One of the most important foundations of the development of society is the education system. From the first years of independence, on July 2, 1992, the Law on Education was adopted. The country has developed a program for the implementation of a new system of education, reform of education. The next stage of the education system - higher education - has also undergone major reforms. In February 1992, a presidential decree granted university status to 8 pedagogical institutes. In March 1992, Andijan State University, Urgench State University and Karshi State University were established on the basis of regional pedagogical institutes. Also, the University of World Economy and Diplomacy, the Military Academy under the Ministry of Defense, the Banking and Finance Academies were established. A number of branches of foreign universities were opened. In particular, Westminster International University, IM Gubkin Russian University of Oil and Gas, Singapore Institute of Management Development and a number of other universities were opened. Today, there are more than 90 higher education institutions in Uzbekistan, and these higher education institutions have established good cooperation with the prestigious state universities of the above-mentioned foreign countries.

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
