

Socio-philosophical analysis of the harmony of youth social activity and innovative potential in modern conditions

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Annotation. It also examines the factors related to the manifestation of creative and innovative qualities of young people in society.

As society develops, there is a need to solve many problems in social relations. This issue is also characterized by solving important tasks and problems in the lives of young people, who are an important part and group of the social life of society. Youth is one of the most important forces in society, and with its potential and abilities, it solves very large social issues, demonstrates creative relations. That is why young people are in the most important attention and view of the state and society, creating conditions for their self-expression in social relations.

In the world, young people are carrying out a lot of creative work with their initiative, social activity and innovative potential. Youth organizations are carrying out their activities on an international, interstate and national scale and are giving the main directions to the solidarity and active initiatives of world youth. The function of youth organizations in solving youth problems on an international scale is gaining importance. Currently, more than 50 international youth organizations are operating in the world. In particular, organizations such as the World Federation of Democratic Youth and the International Students' Union play an important role in increasing youth activity. These organizations include national associations of progressive youth and students from more than 100 countries in all regions of the world.

In youth organizations, the needs, interests, goals, and strategic ideas are of paramount importance in the system of youth activities. In implementing their tasks, youth movements work in the areas of spiritual and educational, political and legal, socio-economic, educational, healthcare, technological activities, sports and physical education, helping to solve youth problems. The Youth Union in Uzbekistan ensures the integration of young people into social life and encourages their innovative activities. The primary organizations of the Union in labor collectives not only ensure the implementation of state youth policy in our country, but also serve as a basis for attracting qualified personnel to the sector and helping them implement their innovative ideas. They are also aimed at finding and educating young people who are capable of active social and political leadership, and serving the further development of civil society by implementing their socially significant projects.

Goal 70 of the New Uzbekistan Development Strategy sets out “Improvement of state policy on youth”, which emphasizes the social and spiritual activity of young people and the formation of patriotic feelings:

“Raising the level of legal awareness and legal culture of young people.

Supporting and encouraging talented and gifted young people.

Creating conditions for the development of youth entrepreneurship.

Forming a desire for a healthy lifestyle among young people, as well as creating conditions for the meaningful organization of youth leisure and the mass development of youth sports.

Implementing a system of comprehensive measures to provide spiritual and material support to young families, create decent housing and social and living conditions for them.”

Many issues related to ensuring the social activity and innovative potential of young people, as well as increasing the effectiveness of their activities, can be divided into the following main groups:

- determining and assessing the essence of youth as a social group, their place and role in the development of society through specific indicators;
- determining the periodical boundaries of young people in relation to their age and determining the distribution of tasks performed at each stage;
- to study the specific characteristics of youth socialization;
- analysis of social and professional orientation of young people, adaptation in the team.

In order to acquire these qualities, it is important to form and improve the social and spiritual image of young people. High social ideals shape the social image of young people and educate them as people capable of performing important tasks in society. As the online encyclopedic dictionary “Qumus-info” notes, “The great thinkers of the East considered the moral perfection of a person, his comprehensive development, and the formation of his spiritual image to be one of the important factors in the development of society. In the process of moral, generally spiritual and educational perfection of a person, society also develops in this way, moving through various historical stages - from ignorance, stupidity to knowledge, from evil to goodness, from barbarity to humanity.”

The social structure of the population of any country, especially the youth stratum, is relatively rapidly changing, dynamically growing and constantly forming, so it requires constant guidance and support. One of the most urgent tasks for each state is to educate the young generation, who are the successors of its future prospects, in the spirit of democratic, universal and national values, and to provide them with sufficient social support. On the contrary, if the state youth policy is not properly organized, problems may arise among young people in any society, obstacles may arise in ensuring their labor relations, the criminogenic situation related to young people may intensify, and social problems may increase.

In ensuring these conditions, the innovative potential of young people in solving social issues in society plays an important role. Research aimed at increasing the opportunities for youth in innovative activities is also of great importance in this process. This innovative research serves as a unique tool in the relationship between young people and society. As a result, young people become the main participants in the changes and innovations that form the basis of social development. Scientists emphasize that “Youth is an important socio-demographic group that will develop social guidelines on which society will rely in the near future. Modern researchers observe such qualities as activity, entrepreneurship and initiative in the younger generation and emphasize the paramount need to develop and implement the innovative potential of the younger generation in the interests of national development.” At the same time, there is a need for youth to work more than ever on the basis of innovative cooperation with state bodies, public institutions, non-governmental and non-profit organizations, economic, technological, educational and environmental structures, which will ultimately ensure social stability in society. In this process, it should be emphasized that the innovative potential of youth serves as an important phenomenon in solving the most important issues in society within the framework of national interests and ensuring the practical implementation of social development programs. The scale of innovative enhancement of youth's social activity is associated with the organization of their deep integration with the processes of education, science, culture and enlightenment and its improvement in the spirit of modern traditions. Youth participate in innovative processes in connection with large-scale positive changes in their knowledge, consciousness, thinking, psychology, and system of spiritual values. As A. Saitkasimov emphasized, “The priority task of legal education is to educate the worldview and spiritual world of youth by instilling in the minds of youth universal and national values, humanism, justice, religion, kindness, love for the profession and labor, truthfulness, honesty, spiritual and moral purity, entrepreneurship, and selflessness.” Modern reforms in the field of education and science require the upbringing of innovative youth, training them to think at a high level, to create innovations, to radically renew society, to prepare them for the struggle for its future. The Strategy for Innovative Development of the Republic of Uzbekistan states: “The rapid development of all spheres of society and state life requires the implementation of reforms based on modern innovative ideas, developments and technologies, which will ensure the rapid and qualitative advancement of our country towards joining the ranks of the leaders of world civilization.”

In the context of globalization, it is important to solve youth problems, to rely on the significant support of society in this system. One more reason why solving youth problems has become so urgent recently can be given. E. Omelchenko, approaching the youth problem from a historical point of view, interprets it as follows:

“with the development of industry, the growth of cities and the mass migration of the population, especially young people, to cities, there was a break in the education of youth, which had been formed over the centuries.” The specificity of measures in the field of working with youth and helping them find their place in social life is characterized by the organic and systematic nature of their interaction with youth life and the existing society. This process determines the need to make high demands on young people not only from a professional and qualification point of view, but also in moral, spiritual, cultural, and spiritual aspects. In this process of social relations, the formation of social activity of young people is of great importance. However, it is precisely these forms of relations associated with social views in the minds of young people that determine the approaches to the correct assessment of their place in social life.

Constantly increasing the innovative activity of young people, creating a scientific and creative environment for them to acquire modern knowledge and implement innovations in practical life is an urgent issue. These important measures, based on the requirements of the times, determine the prospects of society and create important innovative traditions in its comprehensive development. As O. Mukhammadjonov emphasized, “Creating conditions for the comprehensive development and upbringing of the younger generation has been a priority direction of state policy in the interests of youth since the first years of Uzbekistan's independence. Because this is an investment in the future.”

In conclusion, the process of harmoniously improving the social activity and innovative potential of young people is also related to the manifestation of their progressive initiatives, intellectual development, the formation of various information and communication systems, programs of measures, and the organization of various social, cultural and educational events. This serves as an important factor in the deepening of relations between young people and society in society, the manifestation of their creative and innovative qualities.

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
